



Recommended Vaccination Schedule

Tetanus toxoid	7 months of age with a booster in 3 to 4 weeks	Annually	Annually, booster 4-6 weeks pre-foaling	Annually	Annually
EWT²	7 months of age with a booster in 3 to 4 weeks	Annually	Annually	Annually	Annually
West Nile Virus	7 months of age with a booster in 3 to 4 weeks	Annually	Annually	Annually	Annually
Rabies	7 months of age No booster required	Annually	Annually	Annually	Annually
Rhinopneumonitis	7 months of age with a booster in 3 to 4 weeks	Biannually	5, 7, and 9 months of gestation with inactivated vaccine	Biannually	Biannually
Intranasal Influenza	7 months of age No booster required	Biannually	Biannually	Biannually	Biannually
Intranasal Strangles³	_____	_____	Annually	Annually	Annually

¹ In addition, this practice recommends an annual Coggins testing, dental exam/floating, fecal McMasters test and a regular deworming program.

² Tetanus toxoid is included in this vaccine.

³ We do not advise Intranasal Strangles vaccine until 2 years of age. (Use I.M. vaccine if necessary prior to 2 years of age.)
